One of its primary values is the continuous updates to clinical content and medical evidence, including direct links to UpToDate, the resource of choice for more than 360,000 clinicians.

The One Click Updates tool leverages UpToDate’s Practice Changing Updates feature, which highlights new recommendations that may change usual clinical practice. Enabled by a unique, structured approach to data management, One Click Updates alerts end users to evidence that may trigger the need to modify particular order sets, allowing them to review recommended updates and apply them in a single step across multiple order sets.

Specifically, the One Click Updates feature:

“The simplicity with which this new feature can be executed belies the complexity of the data management systems that support it, and which turn the event into a business scalable process,” Bousfield continued. “Gone are the days when order set changes had to be manually re-keyed.”
